

## For All Parishioners Attending the Liturgy

1. DO NOT ATTEND if you are elderly, at high risk otherwise, or if you are feeling sick (fever, cough, shortness of breath, etc.)
2. To ensure social distancing can be maintained you must sign up on-line [https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSfYtj\\_NovUEYa1y1r67GzQt7H5GN-DJxtAICDQHx4zHRYVJCg/viewform](https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSfYtj_NovUEYa1y1r67GzQt7H5GN-DJxtAICDQHx4zHRYVJCg/viewform) for each Liturgy you will attend and include all members of your immediate household who will also be attending.
3. Liturgies will be held in Marswood Hall.
4. Follow CDC recommendations: for hand washing, sneezes and coughs, no sharing of personal items, wear a mask, 6 feet of space:
  - a. Wash hands frequently (for 20 seconds) / use hand sanitizer. Sanitize hands upon entering and exiting the Church
  - b. Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth
  - c. You must wear a mask at all times
  - d. Sneeze and / or cough into your mask.
  - e. Maintain Social Distancing, at least 6 feet at all times from non-household members
5. Your temperature will be taken by attendee upon entry into the Church. Must be less than 100.4°F.
6. Do not share items with those outside your household. For this reason, liturgical books and bulletins will not be provided.
7. Movement of attendees in the Church must be limited. May not be suitable for young children who cannot remain stationary throughout the liturgy.
  - a. Attendants will light candles on your behalf
  - b. Show honor to the holy icons by making the sign of the cross and bowing. Do not touch or kiss.
8. For Holy Communion:
  - a. Line up row by row keeping 6 foot distancing as indicated
  - b. Remove mask only right before receiving communion, after which re-mask.
  - c. DO NOT TOUCH the red communion cloths and absolutely no wiping of mouths
  - d. Antidoron will be NOT be distributed until the **end of service**. Clergy will distribute while wearing mask and gloves. Do not kiss the priest's hand.
9. Please exit immediately after the liturgy, do not linger, no handshaking or hugs. No coffee hour.
10. No offering tray will be passed. We encourage mailing your offering or submitting an online donation, however if these options do not work for you please leave your offering at the candle donation location.
11. No nursery or child care will be offered
12. No Koliva for memorials (exception Saturday of Souls, June 6, email or mail names to priest).
